DMV Certification of Attendance

Permit

In order to get a driver's permit a student must have the DMV Certification of Attendance - Form 301. This form is valid for 60 days, so please plan ahead. Other required documents can be found here: <u>https://dmvnv.com/nvdlteens.htm</u>

The Attendance Form <u>must</u> be requested by a parent or guardian through webmail Cassandra Appleton.

Phone calls or student requests <u>cannot</u> be fulfilled.

IMPORTANT: Students must meet the minimum attendance participation requirements. Because Nevada Connections Academy is a virtual school, attendance is counted as course participation. In order for a student to be counted as attending each course, a student must maintain a 60% or better in at least half of their classes and be on track with their lesson completion for each course. If they are in academic probation or in truancy the form request will be denied.

Driver's License

The form, requirements, and procedures listed above apply to the Driver's License as well.

You will also need to bring proof of completion of a driver's education course. If the course was completed through NCA, we can provide proof, otherwise you will need to get it from the school or venue that the course was completed at.

Unfortunately, several DMVs in the state will NOT accept a transcript as proof. You must have the completion certificate, as well as the other documents listed on the website here: <u>https://dmvnv.com/nvdlteens.htm</u>
